

ACTIVATION of GLASGOW EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER – FLOODING

Glasgow, Montana

WHEREAS, spring run-off caused by snow melt has resulted in the Milk River and Cherry Creek rising to flood stage as of Wednesday, April 12, 2023 triggering Phase II of the Glasgow Flood and Levee Safety Plan

WHEREAS, Phase II of the Glasgow Flood and Levee Safety Plan includes activating an increased level of readiness including activating the Glasgow EOC.

WHEREAS, the Milk River is forecasted by the National Weather Service to reach major flooding levels on April 14, 2023, imperiling the life safety and property of the citizens of Glasgow,

WHEREAS, the National Weather Service is predicting 100% chance of precipitation in the short-range forecast, and

WHEREAS, the City of Glasgow will be engaged in emergency protective and flood mitigation measures to protect life safety, property, and responding to the imminent threat of flooding

NOW THEREFORE it is requested and directed that the Glasgow EOC be activated and staffed at a level commensurate to the flooding incident on this 12th day of April 2023.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of this document be filed with the City Clerk, Valley County Clerk and Recorder, and the Montana Disaster and Emergency Services Division in Helena, Montana.
